Turning to God only in times of crisis

Everybody turns to God in times of extreme danger. We see an example of this in today's Gospel. The apostles were rowing along in the quiet of the evening, making steady progress, when a storm suddenly struck. One minute they were in control. Next minute everything was out of control. They did what they could, but it was not enough. And their faith seemed to have evaporated. In their grave need they cried out to Jesus for help: 'Lord, save us. We are going down.'



Yes, in times of danger everybody turns to God. But there are some who turn to God only then. In a time of crisis they turn to God, begging him to rescue them. And they are prepared to pay a high price if only God will come to their rescue.

For it they are willing to give up their worldly possessions, their treasures, their lusts, their greed, vanities and hates. But once the crisis has passed, they quickly snatch their treasures back and proceed to live as before. If our relationship with God is based on fear rather than on love, very likely that is what we will do.

Danger can be a grace. In the hour of danger, we discover a lot about ourselves, about others, and about God. We can do in difficult times what in easier times seems impossible. Why? Because in difficult times we are forced to call on more of our inner resources. But in the end, only God can save us.
