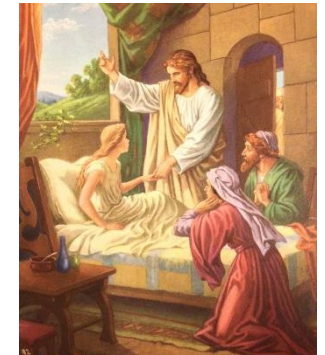

Power even over death

Jairus, a synagogue leader, desperately pleaded with Jesus to heal his dying daughter. Jesus readily agreed and set out with Jairus. Sadly, news arrived that the girl had passed away. Some believed even Jesus' power couldn't overcome death.



However, Jesus entered the room with the grieving family and the three disciples and took the girl's hand. With gentle words, he commanded her to rise. Miraculously, the girl awoke and walked! This act displayed Jesus' immense love and power over even death.

For early Christians facing illness and death, this story held immense meaning. It symbolized Jesus' power as the "resurrection and the life." It instilled faith that death was merely a sleep from which Jesus could awaken believers, offering hope for life after death. This belief is reflected in the term "cemetery," derived from the word for "sleeping place." Both Jairus' daughter's healing and the woman's cure demonstrate God's power over human limitations.
